


BIRD PERCH DETERRENT™ for Distribution Crossarms


Be sure to read and completely understand this procedure before applying product. Be sure to select the proper size PREFORMED™ product before application.




Step #1 Spread the vertical uprights of the BIRD PERCH DETERRENT to position them around the crossarm.




Step #2 Keeping the uprights of the BIRD PERCH DETERRENT apart, position the unit so that the hooks are over the top of the crossarm.




Step #3 Rotate the BIRD PERCH DETERRENT 90° clockwise and position the diverter where desired. Ensure that the hooks are positioned on either side of the crossarm.



Step #5 Slide the second deterrent to position it next to the first, placing the helical upright behind the straight upright of the first unit.




Step #4 Approximately 12" (30.5 cm) away from the first deterrent, repeat steps 1-3 for the second deterrent.




Step #6 Wrap the helical upright of the second deterrent around the straight upright of the first deterrent. Ensure that the bottom helical wrap is installed properly.




Step #7 Continue wrapping the helical leg until it is completely installed.



Step #9 If additional security is needed, cable ties can be attached to the first and/ or last BIRD PERCH DETERRENT as shown below.



Step #8 Repeat the above steps until the desired coverage is achieved. Two Bird Perch Deterrents cover approximately 15.8" (40.1 cm) and are approximately 14.25" (36.2 cm) high.
